4. Duration of the course

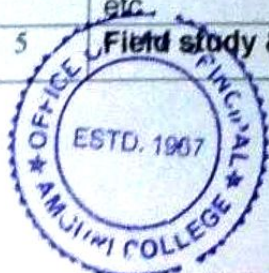
This course duration is 30 hrs
