### World Blood Donation Day Celebration:




### Report on the Conduction of NSS Day and Swacchata Hi Seva on 24.09.2020







**6<sup>th</sup> Day: Discussion and Interaction on Youth Development:**




### **CELEBRATION OF SILENCE DAY AT AMGURI COLLEGE**







## Cleanliness Drive in the Campus:

### Campus Grooming( 1<sup>st</sup> February 2021 to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021):







### Mass Campus Cleaning March 2021:
