Today on 3rd October, 2018 a workshop on the topic 'Menstrual Health Management' was organised at the 'Late Arun Mahanta Memorial Auditorium' of Anguri College. The workshop was sponsored by District Child and Adolescent Cell, Sivasagar and 'Nava Uddit' (New Rise) Society, an NGO working on implementation of UNICEF programs, and was supported by Women Cell, Anguri College. The Nava Uddit Somaj is a non-government organization to provide social and educational empowerment to women and children and works with the District Children and Adolescent Cell, Sivasagar.

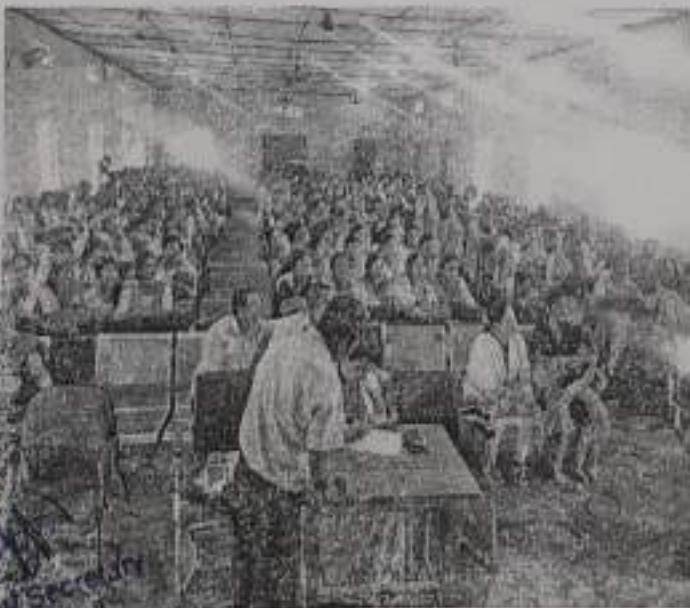
DCAC's WASH (Water, Sanitation & Hygiene practices) consultant Swetangana Bhuyan attended the program as the key note speaker. Prityrani Duarah was another speaker of the workshop, and she was along with her few other members of Nava Uddit Somaj was also present at the program. The program was attended by almost 200-250 girls of different classes of Anguri College.

The program started with a welcome address by Dr. Ashfia Sultana, Principal, Anguri College. Mrs. Nilima Baruah, Vice-Principal of the college and other members of Women Cell were present at the program. The resource persons and other officials from DCAC were felicitated by the members of Women's Cell.

The tagline for the workshop was -
'Menstruation is a cycle and not a curse.'

Ms. Bhuyan in her speech urged the girls to first that they should first change their thinking about their impurity at the time of menstruation. She said that all of us or most of us covered under the age old tradition of considering ourselves impure during the days of menstruation is rooted in our brain very deeply and we must try to get rid of it. Then only we can urge and expect from other members of society to not treat us as impure in these days. She emphasised on following healthy procedures such as the use of sanitary napkin/pad, healthy food etc. She said that traditionally we are barred from ~~to~~ consuming different food items during menstruation but there is no scientific background behind it. Then she talked about the dangers from the use of reusable cloth napkins made out of old cloths, as such cloths without proper cleaning and dived out properly after use may be the source of different health issues. She emphasised the use of disposable sanitary napkin and proper disposal of them after that. She also talked about low cost sanitary napkin that the students can take the benefit of. Moreover Ms. Bhuyan urged the girls that if any complication ^{persist. In long time} arise during the days of their menstruation they should consult doctors without hesitation and should not rely on home remedies. She ended her speech emphasising the fact that menstruation is most natural and a cyclical phenomena for women's of certain age and should not be treated as a curse.



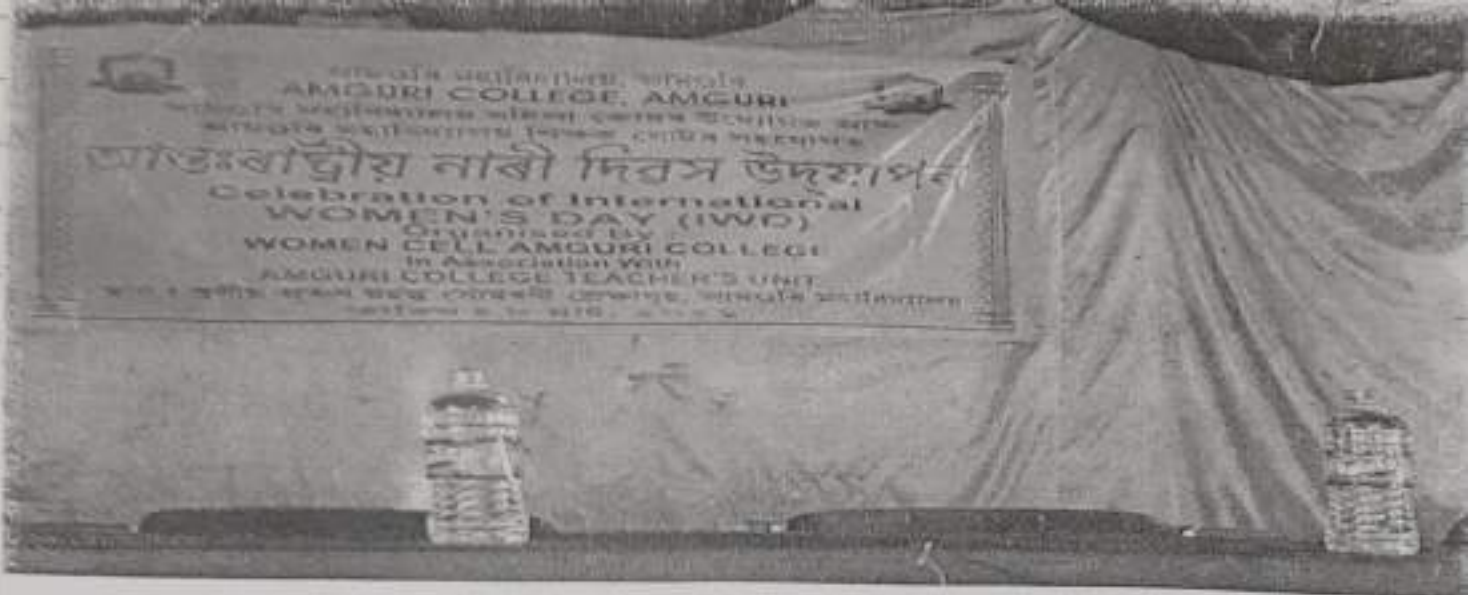

A Meeting on Women Health

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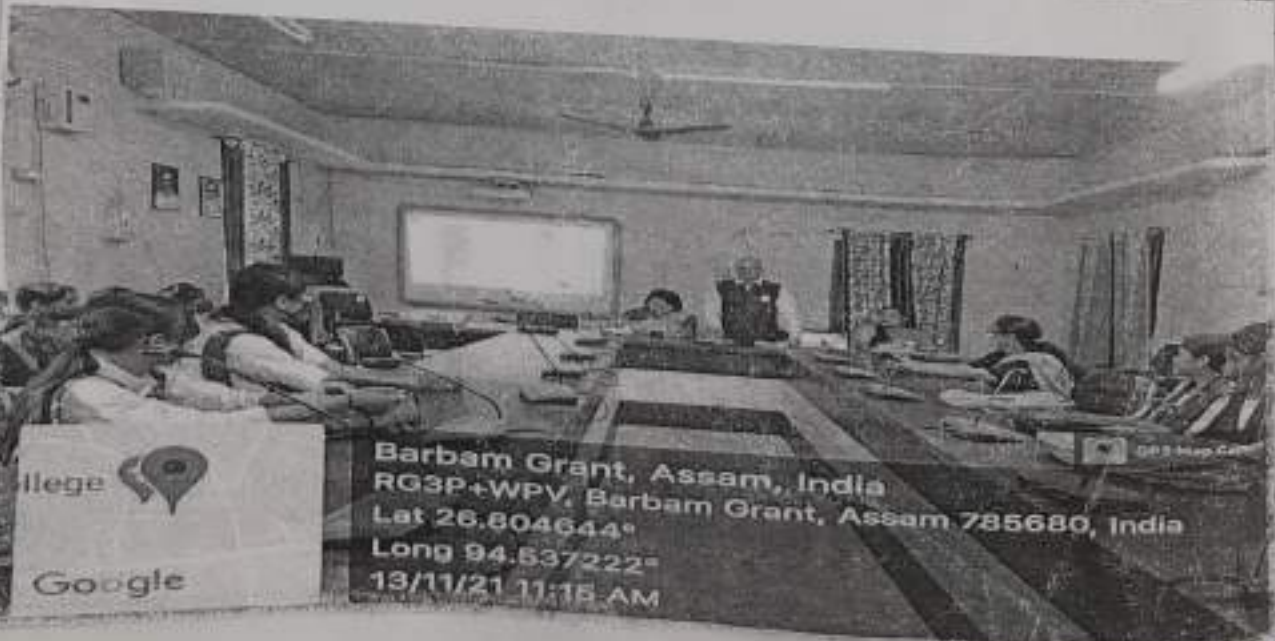
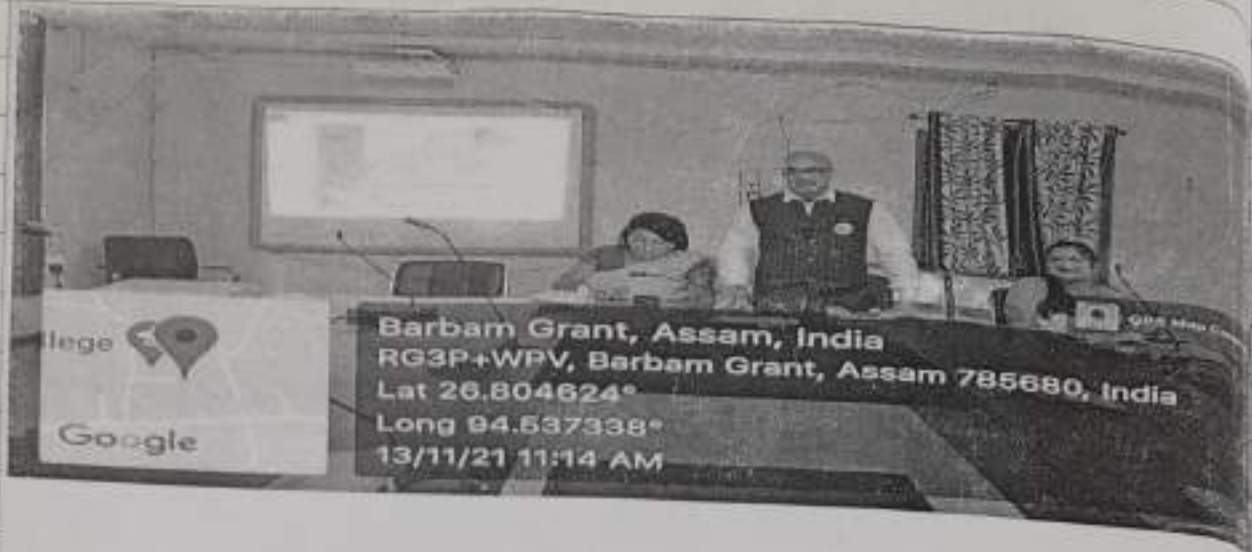



As per DHE Instruction through its letter no Letter No /DHE/PA/Misc/3/2022/38 dated 18th June 2022, Amguri College, Amguri celebrated the 8th Stint of International Yoga Day on 21st of June 2022.

It started with the assembly of students and teachers braving the harsh weather at 7:30 P.M. in the premises of the college besides witnessing the presence of one Yoga Charya and another Yoga Training Apprentice.

The ritualistic lighting of the lamp was done by Mr Biman Sensuwa Boruah at 7:35 A.M. in the presence of Principal Dr Ashfia Sultana under the anchoring of Sankar Biswas, NSS Programme Officer, Amguri College NSS Unit.

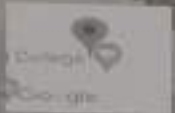
The Principal exactly at 7:40 A.M. inaugurated the Yoga Session with her plenary speech throwing light on the importance of Yoga for countering the menace of different forms of psycho-social abuse and its contribution in lengthening life-span, boosting memory for students, while browsing through history, referring to great personalities like Rishi Aurobindo, Swami Vivekananda and Mahatma Gandhi and the recognition of YOGA by UNO.

At 7:45 A.M. chanting of prayer relating to Yoga was done under the aegis of Yoga Acharya Mr Barun Jyoti Gohain and it was followed by Surya Namaskar exactly at 7:50 A.M. which was continued for 10 minutes

At around 8:00 A.M. Yoga Charya Mr Barun Jyoti Gohain along with his protégé Yoga Apprentice Dipsikha Neog started the demo of Yogasanas. After the demo, under his supervision all the present teaching staff and administrative staff, besides students duly performed Asanas such as Vriksasana, Dhanurasana, Bhujangasana, Sirsasana, Padmasana, Natarajsana, Halasana, Vajrasana, Chakrasana, Ustrasana, Siddhasana and they were informed about the health benefits of each and every asanas. This session continued for half an hour.

From 8:30 A.M. onwards for a duration of 5 minutes, Kapalbhatai, Pranayama, Dhyana were undergone by students and the College Fraternity and exactly at 8:45, Mr Sankar Biswas read out the Sankalp of Yoga Day which was uttered literatim by all.

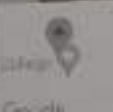

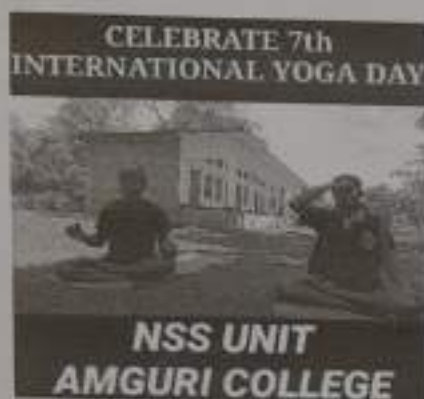

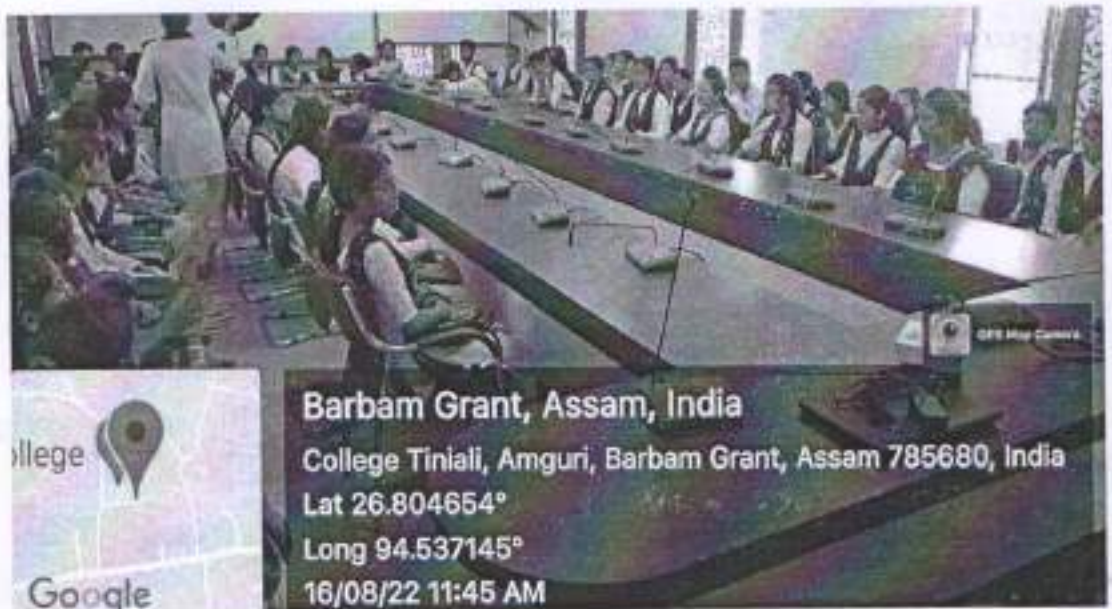
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Career Guidance Program for the final year students on 16th August, 2022.
