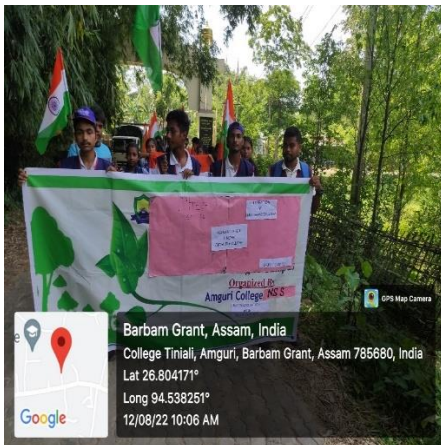


Activity no 3: Prabhat Pheri
